

Junior Sail Camp COVID-19 Policy

All of us at BYC and GHYC Junior Sail want you to know that our primary goal is SAFETY for your child as well as our staff. As the COVID-19 situation evolves we are consistently monitoring and adjusting our programs for Summer 2021.

We plan to re-open for 2021 with any needed COVID-19 precautions in place. As guidance evolves, we will adjust our practices in line with updated local, state, and federal guidance. We are working closely with our partner program GHYC Junior Sail and with the Bremerton Yacht Club to keep sailors, families, and staff safe. The following procedures will likely be in place in 2021:

- Daily health check and questionnaire in accordance with current guidance.
- Reduce group size to 6.
- Single handed boats only unless guidance changes.
- No interaction between isolated groups.
- Reduced overall camp programs to allow for appropriate social distancing.
- Masks required when not on the water.
- Sanitation procedures in place for high touch areas.
- Hand sanitizer readily available.

In planning for the 2021 Summer season, we have anticipated that restrictions may still be in place and have adapted our programming accordingly. We are hopeful that we may be able to add double-handed sailing before camp this summer, but at this time we are unsure if the situation will be improved enough to do so responsibly.
